TU Wien Academic Press is a **scientific open access publisher** and is operated as a service by TU Wien Bibliothek.

We publish books from **TU Wien's entire range of subjects** and authored by **members of the university** (academics, lecturers, visiting scientists and doctoral students).

The classic format is the **open access e-book** – a professional electronic book publication that is protected by licence and that is freely available for download from the Internet. This option is **free of charge** and thus supports researchers in the sense of TU Wien's open access policy. We also offer the option of publication and distribution as **print publications**.

PUBLISHING PROGRAMME

TU Wien Academic Press publishes books (monographs, edited works, thematic anthologies, etc.)

- > from within the classic research context,
- **from research-led teaching** (not including textbooks and lecture scripts, however),
- **doctoral theses** or
- **conference proceedings** (but no volumes of abstracts).

Books by TU Wien Academic Press are published either as academic **monographs** or as part of a **series of publications**. The publisher establishes such series of publications in consultation with the scientists, institutes and faculties working at TU Wien.

Peer reviews are standard for us. We have adapted the peer review procedures to the various types of publication with the aim of ensuring efficient quality assurance.
