FUNDING OPTIONS AVAILABLE FROM THE PUBLISHER

We are pleased that we are in a position to be able to offer funding to authors and editors. This information sheet summarises all the information about the TU Wien Academic Press' funding options.

We will already discuss the financing of the publication of your book with you as our cooperation commences. A positive funding agreement will be included in the contract with you. We'd be happy to inform you about other possible sources of funding if no funding is available from TU Wien Academic Press (please refer to the information sheet 'Funding options for book publications in Austria'.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The prerequisite for funding from the TU Wien Academic Press is that there are no other funds available to the author or the publisher to cover the costs and that it would therefore be necessary to draw on personal funds.

The following funding by TU Wien Academic Press is possible:

1. Individual linguistic, graphic or licensing measures to improve the readability of a book

- Example: The book has been written in English by a non-native speaker who is very fluent in the language but readability could be improved further by English proofreading.
- Example: Licence costs would be incurred for the use of images (such as photographs) in the book that are relevant to scientific efforts (which therefore cannot be replaced by images in the public domain).
- Example: A book is to be made accessible to visually impaired people (barrier-free). This would involve additional technical or graphic costs.

2. Funding within the framework of the strategic orientation of TU Wien, in particular where the works relate to TU Wien's following areas of strategic activities:

- a. Advancement of junior scientists
- b. Advancement of the internationalisation of research and teaching
- c. Advancement of knowledge and innovation transfer
- Example: Excellent doctoral thesis or book publication within the framework of structured doctoral training
- Example: Book publications within the framework of international joint- or double-degree programmes
- Example: A public book print with subsequent open peer review is to be used for the publication of a book by a team of authors; additional costs will be incurred for implementation (quality assurance, securing social transfer).



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The works to be awarded funding are selected by a committee at TU Wien Bibliothek.

The availability of funds must always be verified before TU Wien Academic Press may consent to the assumption of costs in the event of a favourable assessment of the content.

Funding from TU Wien Academic Press may also be approved for only part of the costs that an application was made for and for a limited time only.
