Brief introduction WWTF

WWTF: Distinctive features

- ➤ The only larger Austrian private non-profit organisation established to promote science and research
- ➤ Founded in 2001 | Funding since 2003: over 165 Mio. € have been awarded (Private foundation, City of Vienna)
- WWTF Mission:
 - ➤ We fund top scientific research in Vienna
 - We provide substantial funding for larger research projects and bring research group leaders from abroad to Vienna
 - We run competitive calls according to highest international standards

Details of the call ESR 2020

Details of the current call – ESR20

- 2 stage selection process:
 - Short proposal deadline: 23.01.2020
 - Full proposal deadline: 20.05.2020
- Funding range: 200 000 € 650 000 €
- 2 4 year research projects on cutting-edge research
- Total budget: 4.5 Mio €

Scope of the "ESR - Urban Regions" Call I

- Clearly identified research questions focused on phenomena occurring in cities or caused by cities or urban processes
- Systemic approach addressing challenges with long term relevance
- Analyzing human-environment-interactions
- Holistic and multi-faceted approaches covering different environmental"-spheres" in urban areas
- Interdisciplinary nature including complementary disciplines from natural sciences, social sciences, humanities, engineering
- Include collaborators with experience in interdisciplinary research/methodology

Scope of the "ESR - Urban Regions" Call II

- Predictive modelling approaches and visualization strongly encouraged
- Project designs going far beyond monitoring
- Research not restricted to Vienna
- Include and explain potential sex-specific and gender-related aspects where relevant

WWTF Gender Policy

Our objectives are to:


- to implement gender-neutral processes
- raise awareness of gender bias (applicants, reviewers, panels)
- use evaluation criteria that account for career breaks and atypical career paths e.g. due to family circumstances
- Balanced teams & encourage more female researchers to apply as PIs of cutting-edge research projects
- New: Inclusion of potential sex-specific or gender-related aspects in the respective parts of the proposal
 - ► <u>Information document available online</u>


WWTF Projects

- Funding: € 200.000 € 650.000 per project
- Up to 3 researchers per project core team (Short Proposal)
- One designated coordinator
- Coordinator must be affiliated to a Viennese University or nonuniversity research institute
- Project partners can be based world-wide. Up to 20% of funding for researchers may be allocated outside Vienna
- A researcher can appear in two proposals at most

New: Joint Projects

- Collaboration between researchers in Vienna and Lower Austria on comparable terms
- PI in Vienna, Co-PI in Lower Austria
 - Vienna: Min. 51% budget
 - Lower Austria: 20%-49% budget
 - Optional: Other partners up to 20% budget
- Funding: up to € 750.000 per project
- Regional branches of Viennese institutions located in Lower Austria are considered as Viennese partners






Jury

- ~7 internationally renowned scientists with expertise relevant to the call (names to be released after the funding decision)
- Duties and responsibilities:
 - · Selection of short proposals for next stage
 - Nomination of reviewers
 - Comparative assessment of the proposals and funding decision

Decision Short Proposal

- Projects will not go on to the next stage if they are outside the scope of the call or do not meet international quality standards.
- Between 20-30 proposals invited to full proposal phase
- Applicants will be informed immediately in both cases.




Full Proposal Submission

Via the online submission system

Peer Review-Process

- Applicants must suggest 5 reviewers
 - Please insert representative key words
- Applicants may exclude up to 3 reviewers
- A minimum of three reviews per proposal.
- Only (anonymous) international reviewers.
- Reviews form the basis of the jury discussion.




Jury recommendation

Main evaluation criteria:

- Scientific quality and innovativeness
- Scope and relevance of the project
- Appropriate **approach** to address **clear** research question
- Feasability of the working plan presented with Gantt-chart
- Interdisciplinarity, collaboration, expertise and composition of the team
- Consideration of sex-specific or gender-related aspects

Decision

- Formal decision by the board of directors
- All applicants will receive a decision letter (rejections and acceptances) with anonymous reviews



- Funding contract is between WWTF and the coordinator's host institution (according to § 27 of the 2002 University Law)
- Coordinator has scientific and financial responsibility for the project
- Project start by April 2021 at the latest

Submission system

- ► Registration with e-mail address and name at https://funding.wwtf.at
- Login, select the call and click on "create a new proposal"
- Complete the proposal, upload necessary documents, and submit (a PDF) file with a project number will be generated automatically)
 - Submission is only possible after the form has been completed in its entirety
 - No amendments can be made after the submission.







- ► Text box input fields, character number limited (incl. spaces)
- ► If applicable: Include sex-specific or gender-related aspects
- Keep applications short and precise
 - use language aimed at the scientific community
 - be ambitious
 - ▶ in English

Ethical aspects

- ▶ If the project requires approval by the ethics committee or has already been approved, write a brief statement (include approval nr.)
- It is the researcher's responsibility to comply with ethics regulations
- Refer to guide for details and deadlines

Submission system: Budget

- Overhead costs: up to 20% of the direct costs
- No funding of companies
- Self-funded business partners are possible
- ➤ Project relevant services from companies can be calculated as consumables (if these services cannot be provided with reasonable effort by the team)
- ▶ Non-personnel costs should not exceed 25% of the total budget
- Budget changes in the full proposal stage are permitted, but require an explanation

Cost Planning Tool





Budget

- Spreadsheet download to help calculate the budget:
 - Per institution and per year calculations
 - Personnel costs
 - in-kind and WWTF funding, use FTE/100% salary
 - Including automatic 3% annual salary increase
 - WWTF policy regarding senior staff: up to 20% in case there is less than 40% basic institutional block funding
 - Non-personnel costs (consumables, third-party services, travelling, publishing costs)
- Do not submit the spreadsheet, but fill in the numbers online







- ▶ PDF upload, max. one page
- ► Include WP and responsibilities
- No data allowed



Submission system: Signatures



- Can be downloaded before the proposal is complete
- WWTF-projects are § 27-projects (for universities)
 - ➤ A commitment from the involved universities or research institution is necessary, the coordinator's institution will be the contract partner
 - ▶ **Affirmations**: Signature of the PIs / Core team members
 - ➤ **Authorization**: Signature of the authorized person from the involved institutions of the PIs / Core team members
 - ▶ Be aware of internal regulations of the respective institutions
 - Contact the research services unit/grant managers in advance

Submission system: Signatures



- ► PDFs will be generated automatically using the information about the core team and hosting institutions
- "Download Part I as PDF document"
- Print for signatures
- Scan signed sheets and upload (up to 6 pages in one PDF document)

Affirmations

In signing the application form, all persons involved (project manager, partners) undertake that the information provided in the application form is, to the best of their knowledge and belief, accurate and complete. They confirm the following:

- · All relevant material changes will be promptly communicated to WWTF
- All persons agree not to exploit intellectual property as individuals, but, if in any way possible, within the set of rules of their Home institutions. All publications have to mention WWTF as a funding institution.
- The persons involved will ensure compliance with all legal and procedural requirements regarding safety, ethic issues, notification requirements and any other relevant regulations.
- The persons involved confirm that the work plan submitted for WWTF funding is currently not subject to third party funding (like FWF, EU-funding, any other regional, national or international funding).
