"... of this course is to improve the capabilities and chances of (young) researchers at the participating faculties to receive competitive public funding."


"... of this course is to contribute to the participants foundational knowledge and capabilities for effectively translating their research ideas into strong research project proposals for attaining public funding."


## **Enrolling for the Course**

1. Application questionnaire

#### 2. Submission in EasyChair

- Author 1 should be the course participant
- Author 2 should be the mentor
- Title: working title of your idea
- Abstract: short description, according to questionnaire
- Keywords: research area/topics
- upload pdf document consisting of a motivation and a support letter
- 1-page motivation letter:
  - your funding need
  - your proposal idea
  - Deadline: March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023 your knowledge of the state of the art in the relevant scientific area
- Support letter from your mentor
  - why s/he supports your taking part in the ProWriting2023 course.
  - confirm your sufficient knowledge of the state of the art in the scientific field of your proposal idea.


Append the support letter from your mentor to your motivation letter and upload the combined pdf file as your submission to EasyChair. This finalizes your submission.



Schedule 2023

### **Selection Process**

- Selection of the participants will be made according to the information requested in the questionnaire + quality of submission
- There will be a *waiting list* of eligible candidates, who may take the seat of a participant who drops out in an early phase of the course.
- Notification by March 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - **accepted** as participant
  - too early → apply later attend seminar <u>"Essentials in National Research Funding"</u>
  - too advanced → funding support (FöWi)
  - waiting list
- KickOff March 8<sup>th</sup> (15:30-17:00) for accepted participants (online)


#### Focus is on

proposal writing and first iterative step, reviewing process, act as a reviewer

- Self Study starts March 24<sup>th</sup>
  - Developing and refining your idea
  - Writing it up in a (training) proposal (till May 3<sup>rd</sup>)
  - Individual consulting: E. Schludermann and C. Maszl-Kantner
  - Review one other research project proposal of your fellows (till May 16<sup>th</sup>)
  - Analyse and sum up reviews you received

#### Presence Day 2: May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 09:00 (s.t.) to 17:00

- Insights into the review processes
- Analysis and discussion of review feedback for revised version



### Phase 3

#### Focus is on

finishing up a revised version of your proposal, preparing response to reviewers, hearing


- Self Study starts May 24<sup>th</sup>

### motivation

how much time and energy are you willing to invest the next months? Is proposal writing a burning issue? Do you need it for the next career step?

#### idea

you have a great idea already to surprise, excite, and motivate panel members and reviewers, yourself, the world, ... because you have already expert knowledge and know what is "hot" in the field ...

#### strategy

you have kind of a plan, but no strategy on how to bring it into the best possible shape and condition for a successful submission
