You intend to perform your Bachelor- or Master-thesis at TU Wien?

The basic requirement is to find a supervisor at TU Wien who agrees to work with you on your topic and gives you written confirmation about that. Without such a written confirmation in advance we can't admit you at TU Wien as a mobility student.

In order to find a supervisor, you can

- apply for a Bachelor-, Master-thesis offered at TU Wien: <u>https://tiss.tuwien.ac.at/thesis/theses.xhtml?windowId=e65</u>.
- or
- create your own topic and find a supervisor for it. Consult the home pages of TU Wien institutes and departments <u>https://www.tuwien.at/en/tu-wien/organisation/faculties-andinstitutes/</u> and contact researchers who are working in your field of interest and present them your ideas. Send a short description of the intended project, your transcript of records and CV. You may be successful - however, there is no guarantee that he/she will accept it.

Since your degree will be issued by your home university, the recognition of your thesis work done at TU Wien remains fully with your home university. Please, contact the person responsible for final projects at your university before leaving for Vienna and learn more about the requirements at your home university (e.g. what is the required ECTS rating of the project, can you write the thesis in English, will you have to defend your project at your home university, etc.).

The ratings for final projects at TU Wien are:

This refers to a full workload when the whole thesis is written and completed at an Austrian university. However, deductions of the ECTS need to be made if only parts of the thesis are finalised at TU Wien. Please talk to your academic adviser / supervisor at TU Wien, in case the rating for the bachelor thesis is higher at your home university. The final project will not appear in the Transcript of Records but you will receive a confirmation from your TU supervisor with the ECTS and the grade.

Please mind that a one semester stay could be too tight – especially if you plan to take courses in parallel!
