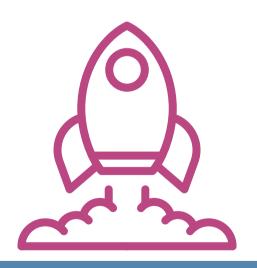

P2P DOC is a peer-to-peer mentorship program that aims to support current doctoral students at TU Wien. By participating in P2P DOC, you'll get to:

- Help or receive help from fellow doctoral students with challenges and decision-making doctoral students face in academic life
- Learn new soft skills such as active listening, communication, leadership, empathy, problem-solving, cultural awareness, facilitation, and more in a real-life setting
- Build out your professional network in a natural and authentic way

Program Structure



Mentor Training*

Mentors receive training on problem-solving and critical thinking as well as cultural awareness.



Mentor Briefing

The mentors meet virtually with the P2P DOC Team to receive more information about their role and tasks



Application, Selection

Mentors and mentees apply via JIRA. The P2P DOC Team reviews all applications.



Mentees and mentors get to know each other during this kick-off event.



10 Mentor-Mentee Meetings

Mentees and mentors meet at least ten times to discuss current challenges and ongoing topics.



4 Mentor Coaching Sessions*

Mentors get to take part in 3 group coaching sessions and 1 individual success session.



2 P2P DOC Check-ins

Both mentees and mentors meet with the P2P DOC Team to provide feedback on the program.



3 Mentor Meetings*

Mentors meet to discuss their experience.



All mentees and mentors meet to celebrate their mentoring journey together.

Mentors' Role

Mentors will receive 3 ECTS for successfully completing the program.

The dean responsible for each mentor's studies will decide whether these ECTS may be applied to the social skills requirement of the respective curriculum.

Mentors support their mentees as they grow and develop during their doctoral studies and navigate important decisions. Mentors offer support, encouragement, and guidance in several important ways.

- Mentors share their own experiences with doctoral studies at TU Wien
- Mentors are a sounding board when challenges arise
- Mentors motivate and offer emotional support
- Mentors empower their mentees to solve challenges independently
- Mentors help set realistic goals





It's not something you finish in a day. It's a commitment, but it's going to be worthwhile if you put in the time and the effort.

I think if someone also wants to have fun during the process, the program helps you with that.

It really helped me grow confident in my role as a researcher. The overall time commitment is not that big. And you get so much experience that it's definitely worth it.

Because being a PhD student is so much different from doing a bachelor's or master's degree that everybody could benefit from it.

You have the chance to develop skills that you cannot develop by following other courses from TU Wien. Just go for it because it was very helpful for my mentees and also for me.

I learned that I have more qualities than I thought I do. And I can bring more to the table. All you had to do is show up and just be yourself.

I think that the value with respect to the time invested was really high.

You will learn a lot of things, you will gain a lot of experience.
