Erasmus+ Higher Education worldwide

Cooperation with countries not associated to the programme (academic mobility)


- **International Mobility between Programme countries & countries not associated to the programme**
- **Student or Staff Mobility** to / from Erasmus+ Partner Countries
 - **Studies:** 2 – 12 months (credit mobility) in a partner university
 - **Traineeship:** 2 – 12 months in a relevant organisation; recognition foreseen
 - **Teaching** (short-term) at a partner university abroad or
 - **Job-related training** at suitable institutions (university, company, NGO) abroad
 - **Short-term mobilities for students for studies- and traineeships**
5-30 days
 - Financial support for travel and subsistence
- **Funding**
 - **Student mobility:** 700 – 850 Euro per month;
 - **Staff mobility:** 160 – 180 Euro per day;
 - One-time payment of the **travel grant** according to distance
- **First info-point:** International Office of your university

Marietta Blau Grant

- The Marietta Blau Grant serves to optimise the content of dissertations through research abroad. Early-stage researchers are the main target group.
- **Target group:** PhD scholars from Austrian Universities
- **Target countries:** all except Austria
- **Duration:** 6-12 months
- **Closing date for applications:** February 1st, September 1st
- **Funding organisation:** OeAD-GmbH on behalf of and financed by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research

Scholarship of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science

- The JSPS Postdoctoral Fellowship of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (Postdoctoral Fellowship for Foreign Researchers) is offered by the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science and enables young scientists and university lecturers at Austrian universities to spend a research period in Japan.
- **Target group:** Postdocs, Researchers
- **Target country:** Japan
- **Duration:** 12 to 24 months
- **Closing date for application:** any time (by July 30th the latest)
- **Funding organisation:** Japanese Government

DaF (Deutsch als Fremdsprache – German as a Foreign Language) internship abroad

- Only students who are studying German as a foreign and second language at an Austrian university can apply for this internship.
- **Target group:** Undergraduates, Graduates
- **Target countries:** including Japan
- **Duration:** 3 to 5 months
- **Closing date for applications:** January 31st
- **Funding organisation:** OeAD-GmbH on behalf of and financed by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research
