- Name

- Occupation
- Data provided voluntarily (in the declaration regarding the scholarship)

In the course of the application, further information on gross income, other types of income or funding, savings incl. amount of savings and debts incl. amount of debts are requested.

Which categories of data subjects are affected by the processing?

Applicants

We collect personal data directly from the applicants.

Legal basis of the data processing

This use of personal data is based on Article 6 par 1 (e) GDPR in conjunction with § 3 (5) and (10) Austrian Universities Act 2002 ("Continuing education of graduates", "Maintaining contacts with graduates").

Categories of recipients of personal data

Your personal data will be forwarded, based on the scholarship, to the following recipients, who are directly involved in the programmes and where required by the organisational procedure:

- Collaboration partners
- Scholarship providers

Data processing outside the European Union

No data processing takes place outside the European Union

Categories of recipients of personal data

We will store your data for the implementation of the scholarship and also beyond such time, as long as statutory retention periods are in force, or as long as legal claims can be asserted against TU Wien, or as long as consent has been granted for this purpose.

Your rights in connection with personal data

You may object to the processing of your data in accordance with Article 21 GDPR on grounds relating to your particular situation. An objection will only result in us refraining from processing your data if the objection is justified on special grounds and the compelling reasons of TU Wien for processing the data do not outweigh these special grounds.

As the data subject affected by the processing of these data, you have the following rights vis-à-vis TU Wien:

- the right to information;
- the right to rectification;
- the right to erasure;
- the right to restriction of processing of your data;
- the right to data portability;

As the data subject, you are also entitled to complain to the Austrian Data Protection Authority about alleged prohibited data processing or non-fulfilment of our obligations under the GDPR.
