CALL FOR PAPERS

Deadline: March 31st, 2023

Since 2008 the **International Facility Management Congress** takes place every year in November at TU Wien. It successfully connects science and practice. Due to the high scientific level the congress is one of the leading conventions on Facility Management in Europe.

The IFM (Real Estate and Facility Management, TU Wien) and its partners have managed to bridge the gap between **science and practice** by realizing numerous research projects and by providing a platform for communication and professional knowledge exchange between researchers and practitioners. At the annual congress the most interesting topics in the field of FM are presented and examined from different perspectives. In this way new and innovative solutions are revealed.

We are pleased to invite you to submit your abstracts and papers!

The IFM congress creates high interest within scholars every year, which can be seen from the large number of submissions. It belongs to the leading scientific conventions due to its scientific committee, consisting of top professors. The accepted papers will be published in the *Journal fuer Facility Management* (with ISSN), edited by TU Wien. Due to the high level and the high quality standards the journal is among the most renowned scientific publications in the field of Facility Management. This is also shown by the acceptance of the Journal by the DOAJ Index.

Repositum: Open Access Publication

The electronic version of the *Journal fuer Facility Management* is an open access journal, provided by TU Wien University Library. All published papers are accessible free of charge. The paper will also be published in the *Journal fuer Facility Management* with ISSN. The publications are archived, provided with a persistent identifier (URN) so that they can be reliably referenced, and made available worldwide online. This increases visibility and dissemination of scholarly research.

Submission Guidelines

If you are interested in the IFM congress and wish to offer a paper, please send an abstract describing the topic as precisely as possible and submit it by e-mail to kongress@ifm.tuwien.ac.at as MS Word file (no pdf). If it is accepted by the scientific committee, you will be invited to send us the full paper and you will receive detailed guidelines for formatting your paper and presentation. If the full paper also has been accepted, you can present it at the congress (November 24th, 2023) and the paper will be published in the Journal fuer Facility Management with **ISSN**. The full paper should not exceed 10-15 pages.

Language

Abstracts and papers should be written and presented in **English or German**. At the congress we will provide simultaneous translation, so we invite especially guests from abroad to join the congress.

If you write your paper in German please notice that you have to translate the title of the paper to English and you also have to write an English Abstract.

Formatting

Abstracts and papers should be sent as MS Word file (no pdf) to kongress@ifm.tuwien.ac.at. Please format your MS Word files and MS Power Point file according to the style sheet published on the homepage www.tuwien.at/ifm-kongress

Licences

All accepted conference papers will be published in *Journal fuer Facility Management* with ISSN number. For being considered, every submission must be provided under the terms of the Creative Commons-Licence Attribution-NonCommercial 2.0 Germany (cc), providing the IFM and its partners the unrestricted, non-exclusive right for publishing and using it in any form (e.g. CD-ROM, DVD, Web or print). The contribution's titles containing information about the author (Name, Curriculum Vitae etc.) may be published in the printed version of the congress program and on the web, as soon as they are accepted by the scientific committee. The lectures may be recorded (audio and video). These cuts are provided under the same licences as the written texts. Submitting a contribution implies the acceptance to this approach. Contributions, that are submitted with any exception (e.g. Non-Disclosure-Agreements etc.) cannot be considered and are not reviewed. All other contributions are reviewed by the scientific committee according to several criteria. Submissions and their contents will be treated strictly confidentially until accepted by the committee. Validations will be held completely confidentially. If possible and desired we will give feedback to the authors on the validations that have been given to their papers or abstracts.

Review

Submitted abstracts and papers will be carefully evaluated by the Scientific Committee based on content, scientific quality and the significance for the congress in a double-blind review.
