


# Ocha Summer Program for Global Leaders - Subject Based Course

# **COURSE INFORMATION**



Please read the following instructions CAREFULLY:

➤ "Subject Based Course" consists of a LECTURE and a PROJECT WORK (both <u>mandatory</u>) with 4 credits given.

As for LECTURE, choose ONE of the sub courses #1~#3 as listed. You **CANNOT** choose more than one sub-course.



Students are allowed to take **ONLY ONE** sub-course from 1 to 3.



#### 1. Advances in Natural Sciences (Up to 15 students)

Research in natural sciences is advancing day by day. This sub course provides lectures comprising five subjects to learn about recent advances in several areas of natural sciences: mathematics, physics, chemistry, biology, and computer science. Students can learn about each subject from basics to the latest topics through this sub course.

# 2. Gender, Globalization and Diversity in Contemporary Japan (Up to 20 students)

This course looks at how contemporary Japanese society is changing in the context of globalization and demographic and social challenges, including population aging and shrinking, with a special focus on the consequences of these changes for gender and diversity. From social welfare to employment, immigration to women's representation in politics, contemporary Japan is facing a range of policy and social issues that will shape Japanese society in the coming decades. How is Japan adapting to our changing world, and what challenges and hurdles remain going forward?

Project Work (taught in English)

This class provides an opportunity to learn about one's own culture by comparing the cultural identity cultivated in a country, region, or community with that of other countries, based on educational practices developed in various countries.



In addition, the objective of this class is to cultivate leadership skills to carry out projects in multicultural groups through collaborative learning. In this class, the emphasis will be on interactivity and independence, rather than a one-way lecture style.

This program provides intensive courses in summer for students of partner universities from both domestic and overseas, as well as students of Ochanomizu University and Graduate School. All classes are **multi-cultural**, aiming for students' **career development** and promotion of **international exchanges**.

#### PROGRAM FEES

- Registration fee: 10,000 JPY (non-refundable)
- Tuition fee: Waved for partner's universities
- Registration fee needs to be paid at the time of application to Ochanomizu university and will NOT be refunded.
- Travelling costs to Tokyo, accommodation fee, and living costs (daily meal, transportation from the accommodation to Ochanomizu University, etc.) must be paid by students.
- Depending on circumstances, scholarship may be awarded to selected students.
