



3rd Grandmaster PhD Workshop in Physics, 2018

Following the success of previous workshops organized in <u>Augsburg</u> and <u>Budapest</u>, we are glad to announce the 3rd Grandmaster PhD Workshop in Physics. This year the workshop will be held at <u>TU Wien</u> from **19 to 23 of February**.

The workshop aims to provide a forum for young scientists to present their results that are of interest for a scientific community, yet in a colloquial atmosphere. MSc, PhD student and post-doc participants can contribute either with oral (25 minutes talk + 5 minutes for discussions) or poster presentations. Moreover, the participants can get insight into on-going research projects in the field of solid state physics and become familiar with related experimental techniques at other contributors' institutes. On longer terms, we hope that this workshop can help to initiate bilateral or multilateral research programs.

The highlight of the workshop will be a one-day-Symposium: From Topology to Superconductivity. Distinquished experts in the field will give Tutorial talks on the fundamental aspects and potential applications.
