

Michael Drmota – Short CV

Michael Drmota is Professor for Discrete Mathematics at TU Wien. His research activities range from analytic combinatorics over discrete random structures to number theory. He has published several books, including *Random Trees* (2009), and about 200 research articles. He was President of the Austrian Mathematical Society from 2010 to 2013, Faculty Dean from 2013 to 2019, and has been Corresponding Member of the Austrian Academy of Sciences since 2013. In 2018 he co-founded the outreach project TUForMath "Forum Mathematik" at TU Wien that organized more than 500 workshops for school classes and 60 public lectures so far.
