Costs and ECTS

Erasmus+ grant: 70 EUR/day for every day of the physical mobility and for two extra travelling days (if you use them).

Your costs: Accommodation and travel costs for the physical event in Slovenia are covered by the participants. The University of Maribor will provide you with accommodation at the student dormitory in Maribor (price: 140,00 EUR for the entire duration of the summer school). The University of Maribor will also offer you one meal (lunch or dinner) per day free of charge. There is no tuition fee for the courses – lectures and workshops. All materials, excursions and coffee breaks will be provided by the organizer of the summer school. **Participants are expected to bring their own laptops.**
